CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS: Student and Early Career Researcher Awards

- **RESEARCH STUDENT / EARLY CAREER AWARD** The Regional Science Association International - British and Irish Section (RSAIBIS) is inviting applications for a student award in Regional Science. Applicants should be either current postgraduate research students or individuals who have completed their postgraduate studies in the last three academic years in any area of Regional Science (e.g. regional economics, quantitative economic geography, etc.). A prize will be awarded to the author of the best piece of written work in Regional Science, which will be judged by committee of high profile members. Submissions should be a published article, a working paper, a conference paper or an article submitted for publication. Full PhD dissertations will not be accepted. Submissions must be single authored. Applicants should submit their work to the RSAIBIS Secretary at the address below (preferably by e-mail) by November 30th 2009. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in April 2010. Applicants are encouraged to submit their paper to be considered for presentation at the RSAI annual conference which will be held in Glasgow in August 2010. - **TAUGHT POSTGRADUATE STUDENT AWARD** The Regional Science Association International - British and Irish Section (RSAIBIS) is inviting applications for a student award in Regional Science. Applicants should be taught postgraduate research students in any area of Regional Science (e.g. regional economics, quantitative economic geography, etc.). A prize will be awarded to the author of the best piece of written work in Regional Science, which will be judged by a committee of high profile members. Submissions should be a Masters degree dissertation. Applicants should submit their work to the RSAIBIS Secretary at the address below (preferably by e-mail) by November 30th 2009. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in April 2010.
- **UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT AWARD** The Regional Science Association International - British and Irish Section (RSAIBIS) is inviting applications for an undergraduate student award in Regional Science. Applicants should be undergraduate students in any area of Regional Science (e.g. regional economics, quantitative economic geography, etc.). A prize will be awarded to the author of the best piece of written work in Regional Science, which will be judged by a committee of high profile members. Submissions should be an undergraduate dissertation (5 – 10,000 words). Applicants should submit their work to the [RSAIBIS Secretary](#) at the address below (preferably by e-mail) by November 30th 2009. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in April 2010.

These prizes are confined to students who are (or have been in the previous academic year) registered in a British or Irish institute of higher education. In each case, the award is a cheque for £100 and a certificate (the names of the winners will be announced via our web-site – www.rsai-bis.org).
